

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE **Pirates! Gadgets! Science!** A high-stakes, open-skies musical premiere at the Winnipeg Fringe

A Steampunk odyssey in the tradition of Jules Verne and H.G. Wells is at the heart of Journey to Kalcedon Island: A Steampunk Adventure, a family-friendly musical premiering at the 2018 Winnipeg Fringe Theatre Festival by Kiss The Giraffe Productions (KTG). Known for their large-scale Fringe productions, Journey to Kalcedon Island may be KTG's most ambitious to-date.

With a book by Heather Madill and Joseph Aragon, and music and lyrics by Joseph Aragon (author of Bloodsuckers! The Musical), Journey to Kalcedon Island follows two intrepid sisters on a grand musical adventure as they discover longlost family secrets, test the limits of their own scientific and engineering abilities, and outwit fearsome airship pirates.

"Steampunk" is a subgenre of science fiction set in a retro-futuristic alternate universe dominated by steam technology and Victorian style. Working on a scale not generally seen at the Fringe, designer Libid Zyla Harder captures the Steampunk theme with an impressive set, over 45 costumes, and shadow puppetry on a 25'x25' screen/backdrop.

Directed by Fringe veteran Leith Clark and choreographed by Brenda Gorlick and Melissa Langdon, Journey to Kalcedon Island highlights the versatility of a stellar 17-member cast.
